2012 Resident Scholarship Program



Get the money YOU need for college!

The Resident Scholarship Program, sponsored by Housing Authority Insurance, Incorporated, provides residents of member public housing authorities with scholarships to help them attend college. By completing the application and providing the required supporting materials, residents who have resided in public or Section 8 housing since at least August 1, 2011, can be entered into a lottery for a chance to be awarded one of 40 scholarships worth \$2,500 each.

How to qualify?

If you are a high school senior, a current college student, or an adult with a high school diploma or GED, have a GPA of at least 2.5, are a resident of a housing authority that is a member of Housing Authority Insurance, Incorporated, and are a U.S. citizen—you may qualify.

Act fast—applications must be post-marked to the address on the application by **April 30, 2012**.
