SUBJECT: Clearview Park/Disston Place/Romayne/Gateway/Sunset Oaks and Saratoga Management Report

Ms. Robin Adams presented the report. She said Disston Place/Clearview Park/Romayne/Gateway Place/Sunset Oaks properties maintained an average occupancy rate of 98 percent for March 1, 2016. Saratoga maintained an occupancy rate of 94 percent for March 1, 2016. Ms. Adams discussed the improvements and activities at the properties.

SUBJECT: Jordan Park Management Report

Ms. Tina Brown presented the Jordan Park Management Report. She said Jordan Park maintained an occupancy rate of 97 percent for March 1, 2016. Maintenance completed 170 routine work orders. Management processed one eviction in March 2016.

87 residents were required to complete community service hours. 9 residents completed the requirement. A notice was sent to the non-compliant residents.
