- 2. Nonprofit organizations such as Boy or Girl Scouts, 4-H Clubs, Police Activities League (PAL), organized children's recreation, mentoring, or education programs, Big Brothers/Big Sisters, and community clean-up programs.
- 3. Programs funded under the Older Americans Act, such as Service Corp of Retired Executives, senior meal programs, and senior centers.
- 4. Public or nonprofit organizations dedicated to seniors, youth, residents, specialneeds populations and organizations with missions to enhance the environment, historic resources, cultural identities, neighborhoods or performing arts.
